

POLICE ASSOCIATION OF VIRGINIA ASSOCIATE BYLAWS

ARTICLE IV

Membership (Associate)

Section 1. This status will be open to all interested parties, 21 years of age or older, regardless of Law Enforcement status.

Section 2. Application for Associate membership shall be made in writing on a form provided by the Executive Director; and must include the endorsement of a regular or lifetime member in good standing.

Section 3. Any member, who is convicted of a felony or misdemeanor involving moral turpitude, will automatically be dropped from membership and may be subject to a criminal background check before acceptance of application.

Section 4. Dues for Associate members will be a yearly membership fee to be determined at the January Executive Board meeting.

Section 5. Associate members will not be entitled to Death Benefits, Scholarships, voting privileges or the right to hold office. They will be entitled to attend all Police Association meetings and Functions and to participate in any business discussions.

ARTICLE X

Method of voting on new applicants.

Section 3. Regular and Associate prospective members must be voted on in separate votes.

ARTICLE XII

Dues, Fees, and Assessments (Associate Membership)

Section 1. The regular dues for Associate Members shall be \$150.00 per annum, payable

in advance upon receipt of a statement to be mailed from the offices of the Association during the first week of January of each year. Those members joining after July 1 will be assessed an initial membership fee of \$75.00 for the remainder of the year, with regular dues of \$150.00 payable after the first of the year.

Section 2. All new applications for membership must be accompanied by a \$25.00 application fee, along with the applicable membership dues for the remainder of the current year.

Section 3. Associate members will not be subject to death assessments.

Section 4. Any check returned to the Association for any reason, shall be assessed a \$35.00 service fee from the Association in addition to the amount of the check and any applicable bank fees.

ARTICLE X111

Method of Voting

Section 7. Associate Members are ineligible to hold office or to hold appointed positions.

The Police Association of Virginia was started in 1941 as the Norfolk Police Division Alumni Association. In 1943 members of the Portsmouth Police Relief Association were voted into membership, and in 1947 patrolmen in the Norfolk and Portsmouth Police Departments were admitted into the organization for the first time. In 1948 the name was changed to the Police Association of Virginia. The Association has grown from the original 33 members of 1941 to over 500 members today.

Purpose

To uphold and maintain the Constitutions of the United States of America and the Commonwealth of Virginia. To promote cooperation and a more binding Association between Police Departments throughout the Commonwealth and, where possible, affiliate with all law enforcement agencies, in a fraternal manner. To maintain a trust fund, to which each member shall contribute, and to provide to the beneficiary of a deceased member a pecuniary amount in accordance with the provisions of the by-laws.
